STUDENT (or STUDENT's parent or guardian if STUDENT is a minor) further acknowledges that s/he has read and understood the Release being signed concurrently herewith and that s/he freely, fully and voluntarily assumes all risks as set forth in such Release.

This agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of California and the invalidity of any one or more of the words, phrases, sentences, clauses, sections, subdivisions or subparagraphs contained in this agreement shall not affect the enforceability of the remaining portions of this agreement or any part thereof, all of which are inserted conditionally on their being valid in law, and in the event that one or more of the words, phrases, sentences, clauses, sections, subdivisions or subparagraphs contained herein shall be invalid, this instrument shall be construed as if such invalid words, phrases, sentences, clauses, sections, subdivisions or subparagraphs had not been inserted and if such validity shall be caused by the length of any period of time or size of any area, or both, shall be considered to be reduced to a period or area which would cure such invalidity.
